Job Purpose and Reporting Structure:

Under the direction of the Drop-in Center Program Manager, the Peer Specialist provides a youth's perspective to programs involving individual RHY and prevention efforts while performing the duties below.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist in facilitating homeless prevention education, social, and supportive groups, as well as peer facilitator training activities. Provide feedback on group topics, strategies, and problematic areas, and work with at least one group per week.
- Serve as a connection between adult staff and youth and young adults receiving services, and interact with participants while serving as a positive role model and following program rules, policies, and procedures. Provide ongoing feedback to program staff on effectiveness of program. Provide feedback on possible future directions and initiatives, and participate in their development and implementation.
- Advocate for the program within peer group and present the program's values to potential participants or community groups.
- Confer with program participants to resolve grievances and conflicts and promote cooperation and interest.
- Provide administrative and program support as requested.
- Other duties may be assigned.

Qualification Requirements:

- No prior experience needed, but youth must be perceived as a positive role model within peer group. Candidate must have completed the agency's required paid staff training program.
- Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out detailed, but uninvolved written and oral instructions. Ability to deal with problems involving a few concrete standard situations.
- Must have a valid Wisconsin work permit and maintain established work schedule in compliance with Wisconsin labor laws as they
 relate to minors

Education and/or Experience:

• Current high school enrollment, or high school diploma/GED or equivalent preferred. Required to work on high school diploma/GED or equivalent.
